<u>Topic</u>	Adult Criminal Court Statistics 2018/2019 Released by Statistics Canada – October 15, 2020
Background	In Nunavut, there were <b>1,694</b> adult criminal court cases completed during the 2018/2019 fiscal year, an <b>increase</b> of <b>6.5%</b> from 2017/2018.

In Canada during the same period, the adult criminal court caseload **decreased** by **11.4%**.
