Topic: Payroll Employment, Earnings and Hours

April 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – June 24, 2022

Background: In April 2022, preliminary estimates from the Survey of Employment,

Payrolls and Hours indicate there were 20,500 employees in Nunavut, an

increase of 1,000 employees from April 2021.

Average weekly earnings for all employees in Nunavut were \$1,509.18,

an increase of 4.1% from the same period last year.
