



## Backgrounder

The Government of Canada delivered the first of two federal Gas Tax Fund installments for 2016-17 to all provinces and territories.

The following table indicates this year's federal Gas Tax Fund allocation for Nunavut's communities.

Location	Federal Funding
Government of Nunavut	\$13,387,000
City of Iqaluit*	\$2,362,500

<sup>\*</sup>The City of Iqaluit is an ultimate recipient under the administrative agreement between Nunavut and Canada for the federal Gas Tax Fund, which receives 15 per cent of the total Nunavut allocation funds annually.
