## QEC proposes changes to utility rates

The Utility Rates Review Council (URRC) of Nunavut received a General Rate Application from Qulliq Energy Corporation (QEC) on March 24, 2022. The application was forwarded by the Minister Responsible for the Qulliq Energy Corporation for the URRC's review and recommendation.

In the application, QEC has proposed changes to rates for test year 2022/2023 that would see a 5.1% increase. This would begin a realignment of the existing community-based rates to phase in territory-wide rates.
