The National Victims and Survivors of Crime Week is from May 15 to May 21, 2023. This year's theme is **Power of Collaboration**.

In the spirit of *Pijitsirniq* (serving and providing for family and community), Nunavut Victim Services will host workshops and events throughout May and June in various communities. Workshops will focus on raising awareness of traumatic brain injuries among victims and survivors of intimate partner violence.

Victims and survivors of crime can access counselling by referral from Victim Services; help with Court of Justice processes, such as preparing victim impact statements; and resources for families affected by Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women and Girls.
