

Qikiqtani, Kivalliq and Kitikmeot Region Health Services

- Community health centres will operate with emergency services during the holiday closure period with 24/7 on-call services for emergency care and triage for all necessary care. There will be no disruption to urgent and necessary care.
- Health centre staff are deemed essential and thus will work during the holiday closure dates, as scheduled by their supervisor.
- Continuing Care Centres and Elders' facilities will be fully operational during the holiday closure period.
- Postponed services:
 - Routine clinics such as chronic disease management, well-child immunizations, and well-woman/well-man clinics.
- The following core services at community health centres will be maintained:
 - Prenatal clinics for high-risk clients.
 - Urgent and emergency appointments.
 - Medical travel services.
 - Community members are advised to call ahead before visiting the health centre.

Public Health

- Public Health Nurses, Regional Communicable Disease Coordinators, TB Coordinators, and support staff will work at reduced capacity.
 - TB programs and TB care delivery will function at full capacity.

Lab and Diagnostic Imaging

- Kitikmeot laboratory and diagnostic imaging services remain open for emergent, urgent, and necessary testing requirements only. Routine collection and testing of lab work will be suspended during this period.
- Kivalliq and Qikiqtaaluk laboratory and diagnostic imaging services remain fully operational during the holiday closure.

Mental Health and Addictions

- Mental Health Nurses and consultants will function at full capacity.
- Mental Health and Addictions paraprofessional staff will be off but available to be called in at the discretion of the mental health nurse.
