**Topic:**

**Births**

2014

Released by Statistics Canada – October 19, 2017

**Background:**

In 2014, the number of births in Nunavut was **898**. This is a **decrease** of **16** babies or **1.8%** from 2013.

For Canada, there were **3,777** more births or an **increase** of **1.0%** from the previous year.
