

## Community Clean-ups

### **Iqaluit**

Iqaluit's community clean-up will take place on Friday, June 19th, from 9am to 4pm. Government of Nunavut employees are permitted to take two (2) hours to participate in the clean-up, unless otherwise agreed upon by your supervisor

Community clean-ups are being scheduled in consultation with the Chief Public Health Officer and will follow health and safety recommendations and social distancing practices. This will include regularly sanitizing pick up stations, requiring station operators to wear masks and gloves, and encouraging social distancing practices.

Participants are encouraged to fill out a waste audit ballot in order to enter into a draw for a prize basket.

Bags, gloves, and ballots will be available for pickup starting at 9am. There will be five (5) different stations around the city:

- City Hall Arnaitok Arena
- Iqaluit Centennial Library
- Abe Okpik Hall, Apex
- AWG Arena
- Iqaluit Masjid Mosque
