**Topic:** **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**  
 April 2019  
 Released by Statistics Canada – May 15, 2019

**Background:** In April 2019, consumers in Iqaluit paid **1.9%** more than in April 2018 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **2.0%** over the same period.
