**Topic:** **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**  
 April 2020  
 Released by Statistics Canada – May 21, 2020

**Background:** In April 2020, consumers in Iqaluit paid **0.8%** more than in April 2019 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index decreased by **0.2%** over the same period.
