Topic: **Consumer Price Index (2002=100.0)**
 January 2019
 Released by Statistics Canada – February 27, 2019

Background: In January 2019, consumers in Iqaluit paid **1.7%** more than in January 2018 for the goods and services included in the Consumer Price Index basket.

The Canadian Consumer Price Index increased by **1.4%** over the same period.
