## COMMON TRAVEL AREA: NWT AND CHURCHILL

The Common Travel Area exempts travellers from isolation requirements under certain conditions:

- 1. Travel must originate from within the Common Travel Area.
- 2. Travellers must not have been outside the Common Travel Area for 2 weeks prior to their travel.
- 3. Travellers must remain in the Common Travel Area for the duration of their stay.

## Don't forget!

To travel into Nunavut, all passengers must have a **letter of authorization** from the Chief Public Health Officer.

To receive this letter, email a completed Traveller's Declaration Form to <a href="mailto:CPHOTravelRequests@gov.nu.ca">CPHOTravelRequests@gov.nu.ca</a> within 7 days of your return flight.
