## Topic Population Age Group Distribution and Median Age

2006 and 2011 Censuses
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Background According to the 2011 Census, the median age in Nunavut was 24.1 years, which is the lowest in the country. The territory had the highest proportion of children aged 14 and under at $\mathbf{3 2 . 7 \%}$ and the lowest proportion of people aged 65 and over at 3.3\%.

The proportion of people aged 65 and over increased between 2006 and 2011 for most provinces and territories, while the percentage of children aged 14 and under declined.
