Topic: **Canada's Population Estimates**
Second Quarter 2021 (preliminary)
Released by Statistics Canada – September 29, 2021

Background: Statistics Canada estimated Nunavut's population to be **39,403** as of July 1, 2021 – an increase of **0.2%** or **67** people from April 1, 2021.

By comparison, the population of Canada increased by **0.2%** over the same period.
