

# StatsUpdate

**Topic:** **Canada's Population Estimates**  
First Quarter 2014 (preliminary)  
Released by Statistics Canada – June 18, 2014

**Background:** Statistics Canada estimated Nunavut's population to be **36,408** as of April 1, 2014 – an increase of **0.8%** or **306** people from January 1, 2014.

By comparison, the population of Canada increased by **0.2%** over the same period.
