## Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Katimajiit

#### Purpose:

The Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Katimajiit provides advice and assistance with Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit to the Government of Nunavut. The Katimajiit is an external body, providing a non-governmental advisory resource for all departments to consult on their Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit initiatives. Working with the interdepartmental Tuttarviit, the Katimajiit assists in government efforts to achieve an Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit approach in its service delivery and day-to-day operations. The Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Katimajiit does not limit departments in pursuing additional consultations, as required.

#### Who is eligible?

Respected individuals in their home communities with previous experience in working on community or territorial committees where consensus decision-making is the norm. Members will have well formed views on Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit and its potential for improving government operations.

### How is the recipient selected?

Nominations for appointment to the Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Katimajiit are accepted from Members of the Legislative Assembly, Inuit organizations and community governments. Cabinet appoints members to serve for terms of up to 3 years. Members are eligible to serve as members for a maximum of 2 consecutive terms.

The Department of Culture and Heritage administers appointments, and presents names to Cabinet for review and approval.
