REGISTRATION AND DE-REGISTRATION FORMS



The registration and de-registration process for Nunavut Territorial Parks has been established to help park visitors have a safe and enjoyable experience. Registration is mandatory for all visitors to Katannilik Territorial Park. A Nunavut Territorial Parks Registration and De-registration Form must be completed and signed jointly by group leaders and registration staff.

Group leaders must acknowledge that all group members have read and understood the "Safe and Sustainable Travel" as well as "Polar Bear Safety" information provided by Nunavut Territorial Parks.

Group leaders are also required to de-register at the end of their trip. If a group does not return by the date agreed upon on the registration form, a search and rescue effort will be initiated. You must remember to de-register.

All search and rescue costs are the responsibility of the visitor. ■

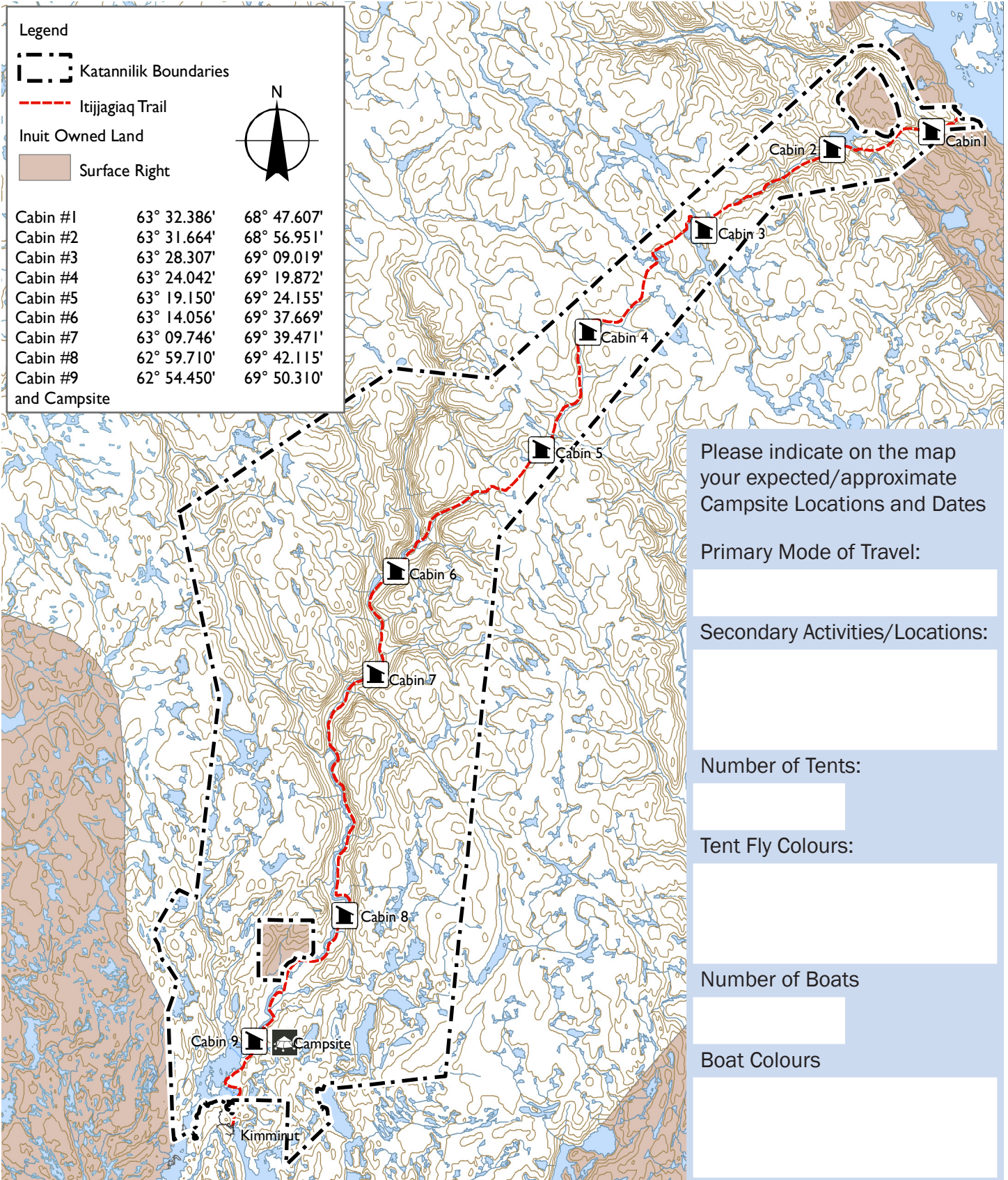

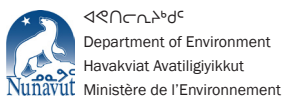
