Topic: Investment in New Housing Construction
 July 2018
 Released by Statistics Canada – September 20, 2018

Background: Investment in new construction in Nunavut totalled **\$0.7 million** in July 2018, a **decrease** of **62.0%** from July 2017.

In Canada, investment in new construction **increased** by **1.7%** from July 2017.
