Topic: **Job Vacancy and Wage Survey**
Fourth Quarter 2020
Released by Statistics Canada – March 25, 2021

Background: In Nunavut, there were **375** job vacancies during the Fourth Quarter of 2020. The wage offered for vacant positions varied notably by province and territory with Nunavut (**34.75**) having the highest wages offered, followed by Northwest Territories (**\$28.45**).
