PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, S. Nu. 2016, c. 13

MANDATORY ISOLATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS:

- A. The Minister of Health has declared a Public Health Emergency in Nunavut effective March 20, 2020 to address the novel coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic;
- B. Pursuant to section 41(1) of the *Public Health Act*, the Chief Public Health Officer may take certain actions, including issuing directions or orders for the purposes of protecting the public health and preventing, remedying or mitigating the effects of the public health emergency; and
- C. Pursuant to section 55(1) of the Act, the Chief Public Health Officer has reasonable grounds to believe that you have been exposed to a communicable disease; namely novel coronavirus COVID-19, and this disease presents a serious risk to public health:

THEREFORE, I, _____ agree to do the following:

- 1. I will isolate for fourteen (14) days at _____.
- 2. I will follow the directions of the Chief Public Health Officer and remain at the isolation facility until I am authorized to leave.
- 3. During my isolation, I will conduct myself in a manner that will not expose others to infection and will take precautions to prevent or limit the direct or indirect transmission of novel coronavirus COVID-19 to others.
- 4. I acknowledge that if I do not follow the isolation measures in this agreement, I may become subject to an order under the public health legislation in the applicable province or territory.
- 5. I acknowledge that I will not be permitted to return to Nunavut until I complete fourteen (14) days of isolation.
