Sport Fishing Licence fee change

Start Date: March 25, 2020 End Date: April 1, 2020

Nunavut-wide 45 sec

Sport Fishing Licence fees in Nunavut are increasing by 2.2 per cent as of April 1, 2020.

The federal *Service Fees Act* requires an annual increase for licences issued under federal legislation, including Sport Fishing Licences, which are issued under the federal *Fisheries Act*.

For a complete breakdown in prices and why they're increasing, please review this year's Sport Fishing Guide, available on the <u>Department of Environment's website</u> or at your local Wildlife Office.

Under the *Fisheries Act*, all non-Nunavut beneficiaries must obtain a Sport Fishing Licence prior to fishing.

Licences are available from the Department of Environment, Fisheries and Oceans Canada, most sport fishing lodges and some retail stores.
