The Department of Education recognizes the thousands of discovered unmarked graves at former residential schools across Canada as a dark chapter in history confronted by many Nunavummiut and Canadians.

The residential school system continues to have an enormous impact in Nunavut. On Friday, September 30, Nunavummiut are invited to wear orange to promote reconciliation, healing and to say loudly: **Every Child Matters**.

Schools, workplaces, and communities can continue to support truth and reconciliation in many ways:

- Organize events that celebrate Inuit language, culture, and resilience.
