- youth transitional housing.
- youth overnight shelters/youth emergency shelters.
- youth programming within Nunavut.

Community-based, non-profit organizations and/or municipal corporations can apply for this funding. Applicants must provide proof of current standing with Nunavut Legal Registries, if applicable.

The application deadline is February 01, 2024.
