Topic: **Canada's Population Estimates**
 First Quarter 2019 (preliminary)
 Released by Statistics Canada – June 19, 2019

Background: Statistics Canada estimated Nunavut's population to be **39,170** as of April 1, 2019 – an increase of **1.0%** or **383** people from January 1, 2019.

By comparison, the population of Canada increased by **0.3%** over the same period.

- Estimates released today are based on 2016 Census counts adjusted net undercoverage and incompletely enumerated Indian reserves, to which is added the population growth estimates for the period from May 10, 2016, to the date estimated.
