



## Nunavut Fire Marshal's Office (NFMO)

NFMO provides information and services regarding inspections, public fire education, fire department training and fire investigations. Fire safety shall be compliant to the requirements of the [Fire Safety Act](#).

### Fire Truck Replacement Program

The NFMO supports the Territories Fire Truck Replacement Program. Fire trucks in Nunavut are certified to Underwriter Laboratories of Canada Standard S-515 with an expected life span of 20 years. A replacement schedule, through to 2028, has been developed by the NFMO for all community fire trucks based primarily on age and condition.
