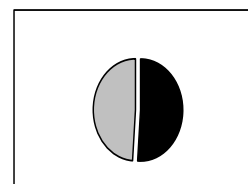

As of July 1, 2016 the total population in Nunavut was estimated at **37,082**, an increase of **550** people or **1.5%** from one year ago.

Nunavut has a young population. In July 2016, an estimated **11,368** people were under the age of 15, representing around one third of the Territory's population. However, the 55-59 age group had the largest growth at **10.1%** from July 2015 to July 2016.

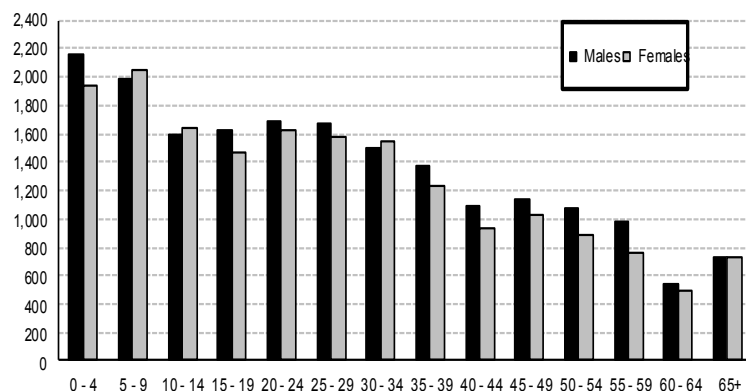
Males and Females % in Nunavut July 2016

Males and Females by Age Groups, July 1, 2016



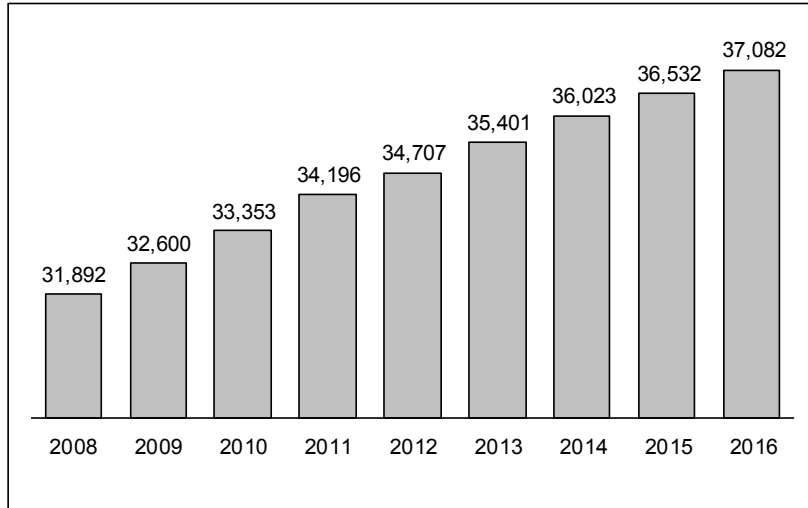
In July 2016, Nunavut's population consisted of **19,169** males (**52%**) and **17,913** females (**48%**).

For the majority of age groups, there were more males than females, with the exception of the following age groups - 5 to 9, 10 to 14, 30 to 34 and 65+.

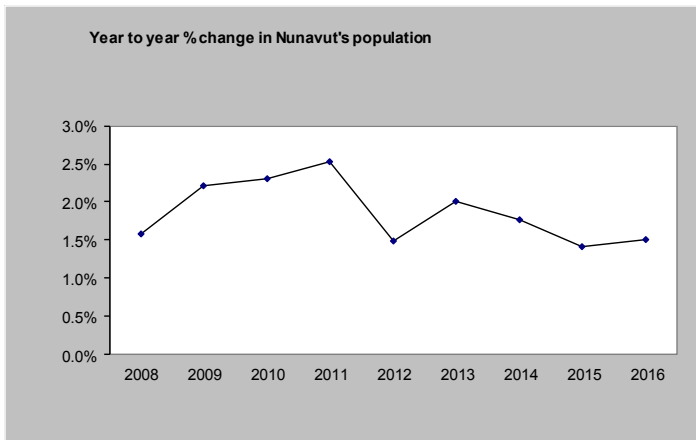
3. Nunavut Population, July 1, 2008 to 2016



From July 2008 to July 2016, the population grew by **5,190** people or **16.3%**. This means Nunavut has been growing at an average annual rate of **2.0%**.
