Topic: Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Education Expenditures
2016/2017
Released by Statistics Canada – September 12, 2019

Background: In Nunavut, a total of **\$219 million** was spent on Elementary and Secondary Education in 2016/2017 – up by **1.3%** from 2015/2016.
