Topic: Elementary-Secondary Education Survey for Canada, the Provinces and Territories
2017/2018
Released by Statistics Canada – October 24, 2019

Background: In the 2017/2018 school year, there were **10,107** students enrolled in Nunavut public schools, an **increase of 0.7%** from the 2016/2017 school year.
