Topic: Elementary-Secondary Education Survey for Canada, the Provinces and Territories
2018/2019
Released by Statistics Canada – October 15, 2020

Background: In the 2018/2019 school year, there were **10,653** students enrolled in Nunavut public schools, an **increase of 5.4%** from the 2017/2018 school year.
