Topic: Elementary-Secondary Education Survey for Canada, the Provinces and Territories
2017/2018
Released by Statistics Canada – October 24, 2019

Background: In the 2017/2018 school year, there were **255** students graduates in Nunavut public schools, a **decrease** of **36** or **12.4%** from the 2016/2017 school year.
