Background: Out of the total Nunavut population of 35,940, 51.2% were males and 48.8%

were females according to the 2016 Census. In Canada, all three Territories

and Alberta had a higher number of males than females.

From 2011 to 2016, the population of all age groups shown in the table below increased. The 25 to 34 years age group had the largest increase since the

2011 Census, for both genders.
