Topic: Wholesale Trade
July 2020¹
Released by Statistics Canada – September 18, 2020

Background: The preliminary wholesale trade estimates for Nunavut for July 2020 were **\$19,950,000**, an **increase of 28.5%** from July 2019.

By comparison, wholesale trade estimates for Canada **increased by 1.0%** over the same period.

Please note that the percentage changes are calculated using unrounded sales figures. Readers should also be aware that the percentage change figures for Nunavut are a reflection of the relatively small volumes of retail sales. If they were to continue to increase over a number of reporting periods and /or remain at a higher level, that would be an indication of increased economic activity.
